Rancho Works Gift and Snack Shop

The 900 Snack Bar was vacated in August, 2013 when the couple who managed it for many years retired. Rancho's Occupational Therapy -**Vocational Services** Department put in a bid for the space in order to provide our patients with a real work environment to practice their return to work skills. In September, 2013, Rancho Works Enterprises started the Coffee Cart Fundraiser to purchase supplies and equipment to renovate the Snack Bar into a Gift Shop/Snack Shop. Coffee and baked goods were sold daily in the 900 lobby by patients and

volunteers of Rancho Works Enterprises. The success of this program has allowed the former 900 Snack Bar to be transformed into the Rancho Gift and Snack Shop operated by Rancho Works Enterprises Apprentices and Volunteers. The shop is currently open from 7:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, serving patients, visitors, and employees.
